Grade Policy

Students must have at least a 2.0 Grade Point Average according to the last printed report card. To be eligible for the State Finals Rodeo, the contestant must have at least a 2.0 GPA on the final semester or trimester.

Students attending a home school, private school, religious school, or correspondence school are eligible for membership if the school is recognized and approved by the State Board of Education or National Board of Education. The contestant would need to show proof that the school they are attending is accredited through the State of Idaho Board of Education.

If the school the student is attending is not accredited by the Idaho State Board of Education the contestant would still be able to rodeo by taking the ISAT (Idaho Standard Achievement Test) and by showing they have proficient scores for their grade level in reading, math, and language.

A contestant may rodeo by showing a GED completion certificate. This certificate would note that the contestant has received a GED and would be considered graduated.
